










WELCOME TO OUR "LIVING SPACE" TREND BOOK.

Black is used to create contrast.


NORDIC ICE



Nordic Ice is a unique contemporary design in the iconic Scandinavian style, combining soft muted tones of grey and white together with an eye-catching woodgrain structure.










LUNAR ASH




The grey undertones in Lunar Ash combine neatly with an elegant woodgrain

An interior design preference that brings a strong dynamic urban presence into living spaces.



A modern take on a classic oak woodgrain that combines a unique interplay of colours to produce a rich natural effect.


CONCRETE

This design theme strives to create a living space in which nature is seen to be fighting back.





BOHEMIAN



A sense of "everything old is new again" but with a contemporary twist. At the heart of the style is a philosophy that embraces the defiant, the daring and the new.


This can be felt in all design elements from inspirational furniture collections, through to the use of lighting and materials to recreate the past in a contemporary living space.

Think black in any colour combination.







Cascade is a modern interpretation of the Moringa tree species, showcasing a harmonious structure in combination with a unique interplay of colours and hues.
